What happens during Spiritual Direction?

First of all, there's nothing mysterious or magical about spiritual direction. Think of it as a conversation between friends: Peter, yourself the directee, and the most important one—Holy Spirit.

You can expect Peter to listen and ask reflective questions. Peter will help you to pay attention to your experiences so as to notice God's nudges, invitations, challenges and confirmations.
